On the LAO Front by Curt

Kevin Allec and Curt Backhaus have applied for positions on the El Dorado County committee, and Mike Fallon has applied for a place on the Amador County committee. The El Dorado County committee will have approximately \$300,000 available each year for the next four years for projects it recommends to the Forest Supervisor for approval. The Amador County RAC will have approximately \$47,000 for the same time period. The funds may be used for projects that improve maintenance of existing infrastructure, implement stewardship objectives that enhance forest ecosystems, and restore and improve land health and water quality. The selection process for these committees is currently underway, and hopefully we will get some Dots in there.
