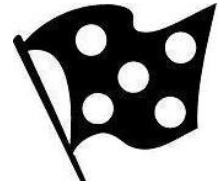

appeal to review the costs. The Forest Service presented a reduced cost estimate for the EA at \$28,900. The Forest Service also provided a few options for reducing the cost estimate even further. These options included removing the wet crossings (4) from the event, and removing some roads/trails from the evaluation process. The Forest Service also wants to include adaptive management in the permit. Also, the Forest Service claimed we were not working in good faith, based on the agenda I presented in the August newsletter.

The third appeal to the Regional Forester has not been returned yet although I heard they were reviewing the issue.
