Since the Virginia City GP was the last weekend of April and didn't make it into the May Newsletter, I'll cover it now. And rightly so it was Ride of the Month for April. Officially kicking off May was the Sawmill Enduro. Traditionally a tough one, we had an all probate crew riding this one with Ryan, Jim Pancrazio and Chris Fleming enduring everything that North Bay MC could throw at them.
