

### On the LAO Front

(Ray Kirchner) I spoke with Mr. Hancock from the Placerville Ranger District I let him know the Polka Dots might be interested in adopting a trail in the Elkins Flat trail system. Ron was glad to hear of our interest as they can use the help. Adopting a trail basically means we will provide trail maintenance. As a group we can to decide which trail we might want to adopt. Any ideas?

In relation to adopting a trail, Yamaha OHV Access Initiative has a program called "GRANT". This program provides money for groups like ours to perform trail development, restoration and maintenance. Once we select the trail in Elkins Flats we want to adopt I will work with Ron to develop and plan and apply for grant money. I'll keep you posted.

Here is an excerpt from a news release posted on the AMA website:  
 The National Off-Highway Vehicle Conservation Council (NOHVCC) has created a Public Land Advocacy Video Workshop series with help from Yamaha Motor Corp., U.S.A. via their OHV Access Initiative, the Motorcycle Industry Council (MIC), the Specialty Vehicle Institute of American (SVIA), and the Recreational Off-Highway Vehicle Association (ROHVA). The workshops are designed to give riders the skills they'll need to keep trails open in their areas; covering everything who the enthusiasts are, planning a trail system, writing effective comments, moving forward from route designation, and much more.

This work shop is on DVD and I ordered 10 copies for the club. There is no fee for the DVD and I can get more copies if needed. This is great information. As stated above part of the work shop is about writing effective comments. We should all be familiar with writing comments as it's one of the tools we as enthusiasts have for helping to keep trails open.
