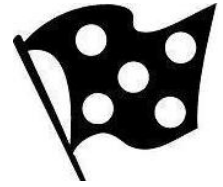

The message sent by the clubs historical decision made Tuesday night May 25<sup>th</sup> to reentrench and dig-in for the survival of the 49er and 49er Family Enduros was heard and echoed by D36. On Wednesday May 26<sup>th</sup> D36 voted to give the Dots a grant for \$10,000 to be used to help fund the clubs 49er and 49er Family Enduros EA. The D36 decision was no less significant than ours. Although the amount is a only a quarter of what we stand to spend for the EA, it will help the clubs fight to achieve a positive EA. However, D36 fears they could face a run from other clubs now facing similar issues or ones that will in the future. None the less it strengthens are ability to move forward and work to keep our enduros in the Forest. For this work out we have a lot of work ahead of us so stay tuned for your opportunity to help out.

In related news, the 2010 49er enduro scheduled for late October is canceled as the FS is unwilling to give us a temporarily 1 year permit while we are in the process of working on the 5 year permit. Sounds like a good weekend for a club campout, fundraising run or other opportunity. We will have to figure out how we want to replace the May ROM as the Fools Gold was canceled as well for similar reasons.

The summer racing season is underway as several members have begun the early summer motocross racing at KB and Hangtown MX. We will be looking to the motocross schedule for ROMs for the summer months. Get it together, as we will be battling the Diggers for bragging rites this summer.
